What is certification?

Certification is the process that guarantees that a specific product, service, system, process or person complies with the set of requirements of different regulations or standards at national and international level. This is an objective and impartial process. Certification adds value to the product, facilitates its penetration in international markets and most importantly demonstrates the commitment of a company with sustainability.



Steps to obtain certification

- 1 **Initial Contact:** Exchange of basic information with the applicant.
- 2 **Formal Request:** Evaluation of the scope of certification, viability and quotation of the service.
- 3 **Approval and planification:** after the quotation is accepted and administrative procedures are completed, an audit is scheduled.
- 4 **Audit/Inspection:** during an on-site visit the applicable requirements to the scope of certification are verified.
- 5 **Evaluation:** the report sent by the inspector is evaluated by the certification committee.

- 6 **Certification.**
- 7 **Emission of certificates and official documents.**
- 8 **Follow-up and monitoring.**
